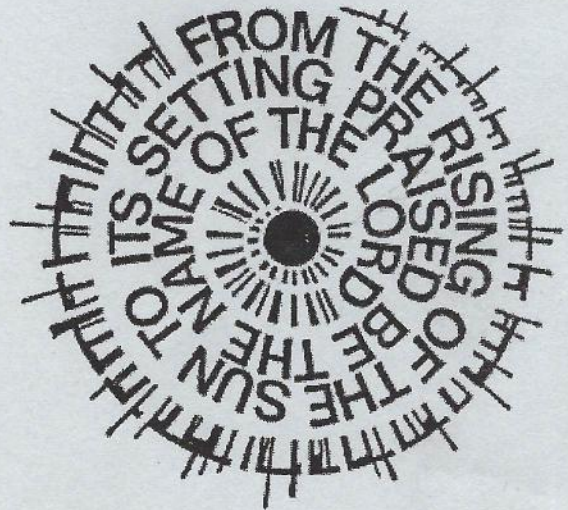
#### A PRAYER

Pray (Sit or Kneel)

**We are sorry and repent.**

**Have mercy on us according to your love.**

### The Appointed Psalm

Stand

*The Minister will say the first verse of the appointed psalm with the congregation saying the second, &c.*

*The Psalm ends*

**Glory be to the Father, and to the Son :**

**and to the Holy Ghost;**

**As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be:**

**world without end. Amen.**

*Hymn* Remain standing

*Second Reading* Sit

At the end of the reading  
This is the word of the Lord.  
**Thanks be to God.**

Talk, Sermon or Meditation

*Hymn* Stand

*The Creed* Remain standing

Let us declare our faith in God  
**We believe in God the Father,**  
**From whom every family in heaven and on**  
**earth is named.**

**We believe in God the Son,**  
**Who lives in our hearts through faith,**  
**And fills us with his love.**  
**We believe in God the Holy Spirit,**  
**Who strengthens us with power from on high.**  
**We believe in one God;**  
**Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**  
**Amen.**

*Prayers of Intercession* Pray (kneel or sit)

At the end of each prayer group the following  
response may be used

Lord, in your mercy, **hear our prayer.**

And at the end of the prayers

Merciful Father, **accept these prayers for the**  
**sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.**  
**Amen.**

*The Lord's Prayer* Remain in prayer

Let us pray with confidence as our Saviour has  
taught us:

**Our Father, which art in heaven,**  
**Hallowed be thy Name,**  
**Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done,**  
**in earth as it is in heaven.**  
**Give us this day our daily bread;**  
**And forgive us our trespasses,**  
**As we forgive them that trespass against us;**  
**And lead us not into temptation,**  
**But deliver us from evil.**  
**For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the**  
**glory,**  
**For ever and ever.**  
**Amen.**
